

Vikings 3/4 Term 1 Year B

Synopsis:

In Vikings this term we will be focusing on the text 'Egyptian Cinderella'. This will develop the children's knowledge on characterisation within a text. It will also allow the children to use skills to compare and predict with the original Cinderella.

English will link with our History learning of Ancient Civilisation, focusing on Ancient Egyptians.

In Science we will be learning about animals including humans. We will begin to dicuss and understand the importance of food and nutrition. Moving onto understanding and naming parts of the sketetal system, alongside the role muscles play within the body. The children will extend their learning to animal skeletons also.

Vikings will follow the White Rose structure of Maths, focusing on place value.

In RE, we will learn 'People of God' and discuss the big question, 'What is it like to follow God?'

In Music we follow the platform Charanga, developing our skills to play notes on instruments.
